### **Starting School (Foundation Class)**

Hertfordshire County Council is acting as the schools' admission authority for initial allocation rounds and in year allocations. This includes:

- Ranking applications in accordance with the school's oversubscription criteria
- Answering queries (phone, email & in writing) about the school's admission arrangements and allocations. HCC admissions literature will reflect the fact that queries about allocations should be directed to HCC.
- Checking the accuracy of allocations
- Producing and supplying individual pupil allocation information
- Producing and supplying school allocation summary information
- Investigating and monitoring allegations of fraudulent applications and withdrawing applications/allocations as necessary

### **In Year Admissions**

Applications should be made online via [www.hertfordshire.gov.uk/inyear](http://www.hertfordshire.gov.uk/inyear) or by contacting the School Admissions and Transport at Hertfordshire County Council on 0300 123 4043. If you are making an In Year Application to Green Lanes Primary School you will need to ask your child's current school to complete the following online form

The HCC service includes:

- Receiving and responding to all applications (10-15 day turnaround time once a full application and necessary paperwork has been received).
- Ranking applications in accordance with the school's oversubscription criteria (including making Rule 2 decisions if required).
- Answering queries (phone, email & in writing) about the school's admission arrangements and allocations. HCC in Year admissions literature will reflect the fact that queries about allocations should be directed to HCC.
- Maintaining the school's Continued Interest (CI) list and allocating places when available.
- Ensuring parents are informed of their right to appeal when a place is not available.

### **Allocation Criteria**

Places will be allocated in accordance with the HCCs published admission rules to which the school adheres.

Rule 1 – Children Looked After or Previously Looked After

Rule 2 – Medical or social (if applicable)

Rule 3 – Linked schools (Note: Green Lanes does not have a linked school)

Rule 4 – Sibling

Rule 5 – Nearest school

Rule 6 – Distance

## **Appeals**

Parents have the right of appeal to an Independent Appeal Panel if they are dissatisfied with an admission decision.
