## Key Vocabulary

Key words	Definition
Phonics	A way of teaching children how to read and write using sounds.
Phoneme	The smallest unit of sound. e.g. s, a, t
Grapheme	The letters that represent a sound.
Digraph	Two letters that make one sound. e.g. ai (rain)
Tri-graph	Three letters that make one sound. e.g. ear (hear)
Odd number	A number that cannot be shared equally between 2 groups.
Even number	A number that can be shared equally between 2 groups.
Weaving	The action of forming fabric by interlacing materials.
Recycle	Taking a material like a plastic bottle or a can and putting it through a process so the material can be used again.

Topics this term!

In our Science lessons the children will be learning parts of trees and learning about the different types of trees as well.

For our Art lessons this half term we will be looking at how to use a paintbrush to create different strokes.

Geography this half term will focus on the continents, oceans, and the United Kingdom. The children will learn what the 7 continents are and where to find them, they will also learn what the 5 oceans are!

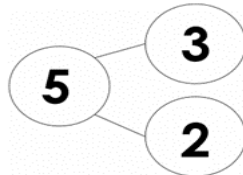
In Computing we will be continuing our Online Safety curriculum weekly and learning about Computing systems and networks and Digital writing.

## Mathematics



### In maths this half term we will be learning about:

- Making the same total in different ways (equivalent)
- Making 10 and some more
- 1 more and 1 less
- Doubling and halving
- Odd and even numbers
- Properties of 2-D and 3-D shapes

The children will have opportunities to explore these concepts using a range of resources and activities.

### Key Vocabulary

Children will continue to focus on using capital letters, finger spaces, punctuation and using the connective 'and' to join two sentences.

### Key Vocabulary

- Compound word - two or more words that have been grouped together to create a new word
- Root words - a complete word that you can't break down any further.
