Key Vocabulary

Key words	Definition
Phonics	A way of teaching children how to read and write using sounds.
Phoneme	The smallest unit of sound. e.g. s, a, t
Grapheme	The letters that represent a sound.
Digraph	Two letters that make one sound. e.g. ai (rain)
Tri-graph	Three letters that make one sound. e.g. ear (hear)
Odd number	A number that cannot be shared equally between 2 groups.
Even number	A number that can be shared equally between 2 groups.
Weaving	The action of forming fabric by interlacing materials.
Recycle	Taking a material like a plastic bottle or a can and putting it through a process so the material can be used again.

History this half term will be looking at the lives of significant individuals. We look at what they did and what they discovered/achieved. We will focus on Mary Anning and David Attenborough!

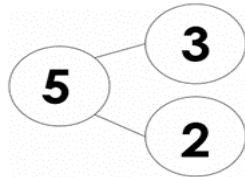
In Computing we will continue our weekly Online Safety curriculum and complete our digital media unit. The children will explore an online paint app to create a range of different art.

Mathematics



In maths this half term we will be learning about:

- Measuring—comparing length, height, mass, and speed
- Days of the week and the months of the year
- 'Think 10' with addition and subtraction
- Making the same total in different ways numbers to 20
- Part or whole unknown number to 20
- Properties of 2-D and 3-D shapes

The children will have opportunities to explore these concepts using a range of resources and activities.

Key Vocabulary

- Once upon a time, next, suddenly, luckily, The end.
- Characters – The people or animals in the story.

- Informal letters
- Poetry on a theme

Children will learn to write the full date on their work and continue to use capital letters, finger spaces and various types of punctuation. They will begin to write more sentences and use the past and present tenses.

- Root words - a complete word that you can't break down any further.
