Key Vocabulary

| Key words | Definition |
|-------------|----------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------|
| Phonics | A way of teaching children how to read and write using sounds. |
| Phoneme | The smallest unit of sound. e.g. s, a, t |
| Grapheme | The letters that represent a sound. |
| Digraph | Two letters that make one sound. e.g. ai (rain) |
| Tri-graph | Three letters that make one sound. e.g. ear (hear) |
| Odd number | A number that cannot be shared equally between 2 groups. |
| Even number | A number that can be shared equally between 2 groups. |
| Weaving | The action of forming fabric by interlacing materials. |
| Recycle | Taking a material like a plastic bottle or a can and putting it through a process so the material can be used again. |

In Geography we will be continuing our learning about continents, oceans, UK countries and Capital cities.

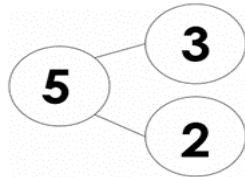
In Computing we will continue our weekly Online Safety curriculum and complete our programming unit using the Bee Bots.

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Mathematics



In maths this half term we will be learning about:

- Numbers to 20 - part or whole unknown
- Numbers to 20— language and problem solving
- Numbers to 20—comparison (difference, more, less, fewer,) including statistics
- Measures—coins and combinations to 20p
- Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s
- Measures—using non-standard measures and introducing standard measures

The children will have opportunities to explore these concepts using a range of resources and activities.

Key Vocabulary

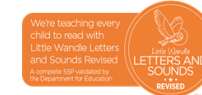
- Once upon a time, next, suddenly, luckily, The end.

Children will learn to write the full date on their work and continue to use capital letters, finger spaces and various types of punctuation. They will begin to write more sentences and use the past and present tenses.
