Key Vocabulary

Key words	Definition
Phonics	A way of teaching children how to read and write using sounds.
Phoneme	The smallest unit of sound. e.g. s, a, t
Grapheme	The letters that represent a sound.
Digraph	Two letters that make one sound. e.g. ai (rain)
Tri-graph	Three letters that make one sound. e.g. ear (hear)
Odd number	A number that cannot be shared equally between 2 groups.
Even number	A number that can be shared equally between 2 groups.
Weaving	The action of forming fabric by interlacing materials.
Recycle	Taking a material like a plastic bottle or a can and putting it through a process so the material can be used again.

Topics this term!

In Phonics we will spend the first two weeks of the half term revisiting sounds and preparing for the Phonics Screening. We will then move onto the Summer 2 curriculum. The children will learn the final phase 5 sounds.

In our Science lessons the children will be revisiting Plants, Animals (including humans) and Seasonal Changes and building on previous experiences.

For our Art and D&T lessons this half term the children will be covering Food and Nutrition and Collage.

Geography this half term will focus on hot and cold climates. We will learn about the equator and the North and South pole.

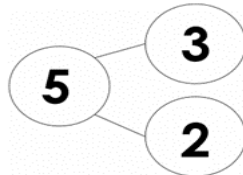
